2. Baseball Canada Rules Interpretation

Mosquito

For minus 5 and above, all bats can be used.

For any player wishing to use a minus 3 bats, starting in 2012, use the approved list of bats supported by USA Baseball and published by Washington State University, <http://www.mme.wsu-ssl.org/certifiedbaseballbats.aspx>.

Pee Wee

For minus 5 and above, all bats can be used.

For any player wishing to use a minus 3 bats, starting in 2012, use the approved list of bats supported by USA Baseball and published by Washington State University, <http://www.mme.wsu-ssl.org/certifiedbaseballbats.aspx>.

Bantam Boys

Note, there is an error in the printed English version of the Baseball Canada rule book under the Bantam Boys division. Starting in 2013, only wood bats will be allowed...not starting in 2012.

Only Minus 3 (length-weight differential) bats with 2 5/8 maximum diameter barrel will be allowed.

Bantam Girls

Minus 5 (length-weight differential) bats with 2 5/8 maximum diameter barrel will be allowed.

Midget

Only wood bats will be allowed.

Junior

Only wood bats will be allowed.

Senior Men

Only wood bats will be allowed.

Senior Women

Minus 5 for Senior Women.

For minus 5 and above, all bats can be used.

Canada Cup

Only wood bats will be allowed.
